- 9. Letter (handwritten, signed) to Rt. Lev. H. Iranjon from P. Fourraic, Archbishop of Canta Re (Lay 20, 1900) 2 pp, (in French) commatulations on his appointment as bishop.
- 10. Letter (typed original) to ht. Nev. H. Granjon from N. J. atz,
 Bishop of Denver (May E, 1900) 1 p, response to Fishop Granjon's
 attempt to refuse the hishophric; must accept it.

- 11. Letter (handwritten, signed) to Bishop (Granjon?) from hev. R. C. Jos. Immel (Aug. 9, 1980) 1 p, arrival in Reaver Creek, Camp Verde, Ariz.; sending honey to Bishop's house.
- 12. Inventory of St. John's Parish, Apache Co. taken following the death of Nev. Feter F. Badilla (Pay 15, 1901) 4 pp.
- 13. Letter (typed original) to Bishop Granjon from Eugene a Philbin, President of the Marquette League (May 5, 1910) 1 p, treasfer of unused \$1000 from chapel of Annunciation fund (Coqui) to a chapel construction fund for the Mescalero Meservation; the name to remain the same; possible future assistance for a Moqui chapel.
- 14. Letter (bandwritten, signed) to Rishop Granjan from anselm Teber, Gallup, New Nex. (May 13, 1910) 5 pp. reason for delay in the construction of Nequi chapel; delay requested by Indian Commission; Me nonite and Catholic Indian traders forced to flee from Craiti; N. Perry asked to take charge; Thornton Miller, Surt. of Hoquis prevented outbreak by forcing group to leave Graibi; site selected at foot of First Mesa; unable to secure consent of Indians; permission granted by agent; unable to secure site for chapel on top of mesa between Malpi and the next village; agrees that money should go to Mescalero Apaches.
- 15. Letter (typed original) to Bishop Granjon from anselm Leber (Apr. 24, 1911) 3 pp, offer to show the site selected for chapel; need for permanent priest at Moqui; church is attempting to maintain too many missions; difficulty in obtaining enough priests for work; forced to abandon areas in New Lexico and crizona to the Protestants; attempt to get an Order to assume responsibility at mission; possibility of making pilgrinage to Rome.
- 16. Letter (handwritten, signed) to Hishop Ornjon (?) from J. Den (?) (Sep. 11, 1911) 4 pp, plans for bishop to visit Holbrook parish in October.
- 17. Letter (typed original) to Bishop Grunjon from Lev. Vanderruesen, Las Gruces, New hexico (Peb. 6, 1912) 1 p, transmittul of church inventories from Dona and and Tortugus: no inventory by former pastor b. Gerey; no account book: no list of personal property; residence completely bare; both churches completely stripped.
- 18. Inventory of Bona has Shurch, Las Sruces, New Feetco, Jun. 20, 1912. 2 pp.
- 19. Inventory of Torturas Church, Las Crubes, New Fexico, Pet. F, 1912. 2 pp.

 5 pp. lists all churches constructed by Fr. Gerard.
- 21. Telegram to the Hon: Henry Ashurst, Bisbee, Ariz. from John E. Osberne, Asst. Secretary of State (Apr. 20, 1915). Instructions given to Consul in Ghent to determine the location of Fr. Peter Timmermans.
- 22. Telegram to the Hon. Henry Ashurst, Bisbee, Ariz. from L. 1. Ckellegan, Secretary (Apr. 27, 1915) Secretary Osborne assigned Latter of locating Fr. Timmermans.
- 23. Letter (handwritten) to Bishop Granjon from A. A. Phillipson, Tucson Knights of Columbus (May 10, 1915) 1 p. Return of two telegrams (see above); no further word about Timmermans.
- 24. Letter (typed original) to Bishop Granjon from John J. Doran, St. Patrick's Seminary, Henlo Fark, Galif. (Jan. 23, 1(21) 2 pp. Eeport on student, James Davis.
- 25. Copy of entry in Calabasas Register Far. 1773 to Arril 1805. Describes death of Fr. Belthazar Carrillo, Get. 10, 1795.
- 26. Copy of entry in Calabasas Register Mar. 1773 to April 1805. Describes death of Fr. Marcisco Gutierrez Pec. 13, 1821.
